The Mt. View Men's Bible Study meets on Friday mornings at 10:30.

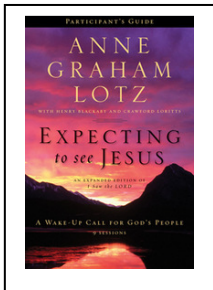
We will begin a new series this January and all men are invited to the event.

Gardeners' Corner

Happy New Year!

Here we are in a new twelve month Calendar Year. Twelve months to improve our gardens. Lots of planning to do to get everything back in shape for summer beauty. Now would be a good time to do some planting, such as canna, calla, crocosmia, dahlia, gladiolus, lilies, nerine, tigridia and other summer-blooming bulbs. Plant some vines for color on trellises and fences. It is also a good time to plant flowering vines such as Carolina Jessamine as a reward, the smell is just wonderful, on warm summer nights.

Now is a good time to plant bare-root roses, just as the nursery gets them in. Determining rose fragrance, we should know that the darker the rose the better the smell. Reds and pinks tend to smell like the roses we used to know. We need to soak our bare-root roses for at least 24 hours before planting. When fertilizing roses in the winter add humus and potash, but be spare with nitrogen fertilizers. We don't want them damaged by late frost. Have a wonderful time on the outside in the beautiful California sunshine, we are so lucky to have.

CHICKEN CACCIATORE

Serves 4-6

Ingredients:

3 chicken breasts (each cut into 6 pieces)

6 thighs (each cut into 2-3 pieces)

1 X-LG onion (sliced)

3 -TSP CHOPPED GARLIC

½ TSP RED PEPPER FLAKES OPTIONAL, (REPLACE WITH BLK PEPPER)1

CUP RED WINE

2 CUP CHICKEN BROTH

1 PKG. MUSHROOMS (SLICED OR CUT UP)

2 PEPPERS SLICED INTO STRIPS (YOUR CHOICE OF COLOR)

3 TBLs OIL

18 OZ. TOMATO "SAUCE"

SALT, 1/2 CUP FRESH PARSLEY

REMOVE SKIN FROM CHICKEN.

BROWN CHICKEN PARTS 1TBL. OIL AND REMOVE FROM POT

SAUTE: (IN SAME POT) 2 TBLs. ONION, GARLIC, MUSHROOMS, PEPPERS (COOK UNTIL SLIGHTLY SOFTENED)

ADD: TOMATO SAUCE, WINE, BROTH, RED PEPPER SALT TO TASTE. BRING TO A SLIGHT BOIL, ADD CHICKEN BACK & SIMMER FOR ABOUT 45 MIN. GARNISH WITH FRESH PARSLEY & SERVE
